## **Do Not Drink Order Rescinded for Towns Riverview Subdivision South, Finney Co.**

**TOPEKA** – The Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) has rescinded a Do Not Drink order for the Towns Riverview Subdivision South, located in Finney County. The order was issued because of unknown water quality in a secondary source used to resolve low pressure violations in the South Subdivision service area.

Public water suppliers in Kansas take all measures necessary to notify customers quickly after a system failure or shutdown. Regardless of whether it's the supplier or KDHE that announces a Do Not Drink order, KDHE will issue the rescind order following water quality testing and receipt of acceptable results from a certified laboratory.

Laboratory analysis of water samples collected from Towns Riverview Subdivision South indicate compliance with drinking water regulations and conditions that placed the system at risk are deemed by KDHE officials to be resolved.
