


## **EES Person View**

The Person View page displays different information depending on whether it is accessed when conducting a Person Search or accessed from the Person Name hyperlink within the context of a case.



- 1. Person Detail Summary
- 2. Master Person Index (only displays through Person Search)
  - Duplicate Person Information
  - KEES Person Information: This information comes from other systems
- 3. Person Case History
- 4. Systems—Indicates systems the consumer is known to: (only displays through context of case)
  - KE = KEES
  - CS = Child Support
  - FA = FACTS
  - KM = KMIS
- 5. Indicates months used of Time Limited Assistance programs:
  - TANF Months (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
  - ABAWD Months (Able Bodied Adults Without Dependents)
  - GA Months (General Assistance)
  - PSE CC Months (Post-Secondary Education Child Care)
- 6. Displays historical program information:
  - A. Program
  - B. Aid Code displays Medical program information
  - LTC Detail displays Medical program information
  - D. Program Status
  - E. Case Number
  - F. Person Role (UP, FRE, FRI, MEM)
  - G. Role Start Date
  - H. Role End Date (If blank, it is high-dated meaning it has no End Date)
  - I. Denial/Discont. Reason
  - J. Case Head displays 'Yes' if the consumer is the case head on the case. This is useful in helping determine usable case numbers.
  - K. Companion Cases displays the case number(s) to linked case(s)
  - L. Worker indicates which agency "owns" the program. The first letter of the worker ID is a D=DCF or K=KDHE. This is important because medical and non-medical programs should not be on the same case number.

Use the carets under the columns to filter the information or data. Only one column can be sorted at a time.
