

WA314 18-YEAR-OLD DENIED AS INVALID PRIMARY APPLICANT IN THE MONTH OF 18TH BIRTHDAY

When EDBC is run in the month an eighteen-year-old applying on his/her own behalf turns 18, that person is denied as an 'Invalid Primary Applicant'.

Example: Application received 6/18/2015 from an 18 year old with a birthdate of 3/18/1997. The 18-year-old requests prior medical and the months are March, April, and May. EDBC is run for March (month the applicant turned 18). EDBC fails due to 'Invalid Primary Applicant'.

The following steps are required to determine eligibility for an 18-year-old requesting coverage for oneself the month he/she turns 18.

NOTE: Step 1 assumes the worker is in the context of the case.

- STEP 1 Navigate to the Individual Demographics Detail page.
- **STEP 2** In the **Emancipation Date** field, enter the applicant's 18th birthday.
- **STEP 3** Finish processing the case.
- **STEP 4** Remove **Emancipation Date** after EDBC is run.
