18 year old Applications Examples

An 18 year old applies for himeslf.

He is determined eligible for MP with a household size of 1. His income is used in the determination.

A parent applies for his 2 children, ages 15 and 18.

Both children are determined eligible for MP with a household size of 3.

In KAECSES, the parent is marked as being legally responsible for both chldren.

A parent applies for an 18 year old and the 18 year old's baby.

Both children are approved for MP with a household size of 3.

When the 18 year old turns 19, both she and her child are removed from the parent's case. The 19 year old must complete an application for both of them.

An 18 year old submits an application for himself. When screening the case it is discovered that the 18 year old is open on his parents' MP case.

Because the 18 year old has applied for himself, he is closed off of his parents' case and approved for medical coverage on his own case.

An 18 year old submits an application for herself. When screening the case it is discovered that the 18 year old is open on her parents' MA CM case.

Because the 18 year old has applied for herself, she is closed off of her parents' MA CM case and approved for medical on her own case.

Note: If the 18 year old is the only child on the MACM program, the MACM is closed. The parents no longer qualify as the caretakers of a child.
